







## **OVERVIEW**

With your support, we channel majority of our resources to build the most crucial health foundation for the underserved communities through The First 1,000 Days Initiative.

We have also rebranded our community clinic to unify our efforts and started a fund to subsidise basic health services for refugees called Autrui 365.









## THE FIRST 1,000 DAYS

2022 is the second year of us championing this cause. It has been a tough but ultimately rewarding journey as we have seen how this initiative can turn a family's life around; from fear and anxiety to pure joy.

After two years, we have seen mothers with pregnancy issues come through the other side with a healthy baby. We have monitored and supported the growth of over 50 babies since birth till their first steps. It has been our privilege to journey with them through every milestone.



This year was all hands on deck as we honed majority of our resources to support the most vulnerable group in our society. We have been stretched financially to maintain the level of excellence and care for the community whilst trying to develop a sustainable programme.

With that, we have decided to work hand in hand with the community to take charge of their pregnancy journey with RM 20 per antenatal visit. This gives them the opportunity to give back to the programme and allow more mothers to receive the same care and treatment.

## **SAW MUN & GRACE\***


It was at the height of the covid-19 pandemic in 2021 when Saw Mun\* was pregnant with Grace\*. Unfortunately, Saw Mun was one of the pregnant mothers who contracted the covid-19 virus and was sent to a quarantine centre to be monitored.

Saw Mun was only 21 years old. She did not have any a support system, but our team continued to assure her throughout her pregnancy. With proper, regular antenatal check-ups at our clinic, Grace was safely delivered on December 9, 2021.

Yet, the battle was far from over as Grace often fell sick. Since birth, Grace has been to our clinic 10 times and admitted to the hospital four times in the first seven months of her life. With frequent doctor visits, Saw Mun knew that her family was not alone in this struggle. She never hesitated to contact our clinic or team members in times of worry and uncertainty as she entrusted the team with the health of her family. Thanks to #TheFirst1000DaysInitiative, both Saw Mun and Grace were able to receive well-supported, quality care.













## **MOVING FORWARD**

After two years of carrying the name Klinik Kecheerian, we decided to rename the clinic to Autrui Clinic. We are grateful to those who have started this work and will continue to serve underserved communities with compassion.



Autrui Clinic represents a clinic that is for others.



As our goal is to enable a fair distribution of healthcare, Autrui 365 is a fund that subsidises primary healthcare for underserved communities. With this fund, we are able to offer quality treatment at an affordable price.

'365' stands for all-year-round because health matters every day of our lives. Autrui 365 plays a crucial role because access to better healthcare can potentially empower individuals to create a better future for themselves and for generations to come.

### **YOUSUF\***


After accidentally spilling acid over his leg at work, Yousuf kept it to himself due to financial constrain. Yousuf finally decided to seek for help at Autrui Clinic when the pain became unbearable.

By the time he arrived, the affected area was infected and required surgical intervention. Our doctors reassured him that recovery would be possible with appropriate care and treatment. Following his surgery, Yousuf still had to travel quite a distance from his home to the clinic frequently for wound dressing. He showed up for his appointments and after 5 months, the extensive wound over his leg finally recovered.

Today, Yousuf is able to resume his work again.







We received a generous amount of pneumococcal vaccines for children from Malaysian Relief Agency (MRA) and contraceptive implants from United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR). Their generosity has enabled us to go above and beyond in serving refugees.



Expenses for programmes increased but we were able to serve twice as many refugees compared to 2021. Additionally, we managed to reduce our supporting services expenses and channeled additional resources towards our existing programmes. All pneumococcal vaccines donated were administered to refugee children. We continue to create awareness for contraception by providing free contraceptive implants to refugee women.

## **FINANCIALS**





#### RM 45,868.61 Autrui 365

This includes the support of 30% off the refugee's medical bill at Autrui Clinic.

In 2021, we modelled a tier discount system for primary care services. However, we were unable to develop a reliable vetting process and have since decided on maintaining a fixed subsidy of 30% for all refugees. A survey was conducted in the community before implementing the subsidy. However, subsidies beyond 30% are still given on case to case basis.


# RM 186,278.65 The First 1,000 Days Initiative

This includes antenatal and postpartum treatment, child vaccinations and children primary care.

As the amount of pregnant refugee mothers more than doubled that of 2021, the majority of our resources supported our flagship programme; The First 1,000 Days Initiative. Although a fee of RM 20 per antenatal visit was implemented in 2022, children vaccinations and primary care services for children still remained fully subsidised.

## **STATISTICS**





All donations were fully utilised in 2022 to provide healthcare services to refugees. A total of 805 refugees benefited from the generous contributions from donors in 2022.


